

HOW DO I GET STARTED WITH HEALTH SHARING?

Thank you for your interest in becoming a part of the Universal HealthShare member community! Here are the basic steps you will follow when you begin sharing your medical needs.

WHEN YOU HAVE A MEDICAL NEED...

You can see a doctor with Telemedicine any time 24/7 with a \$0 consultation fee. Or, if you'd prefer to see your doctor in person, you can choose from over 700,000 doctors and other providers in the Multiplan/PHCS Practitioners & Ancillary Network.

AT YOUR DOCTOR'S OFFICE...

Show your Universal HealthShare Membership Card and all you should need to pay up front is your consultation fee. (If you use Telemedicine instead, your consultation fee is always \$0.)

CONSULT YOUR DOCTOR

Obtain advice, treatment, and make decisions about your health just as you normally would. Please be aware that, while there are no waiting periods for doctor's visits, there are for routine lab tests, follow-up procedures, and many other services that may also be sharable through Universal HealthShare after a waiting period as short as 30 days, depending on your program.

YOUR DOCTOR SENDS US THE BILL

Once your doctor submits your bill, Universal HealthShare will arrange for other members' contributions to be used to pay the part of your bill that's eligible for sharing.

SHARE YOUR MEDICAL EXPENSES

If you've paid your consultation fee, there may be no additional cost. Costly services and procedures outside of office visits will have no upfront out of pocket expenses. Universal Health Fellowship will pay your doctor directly for the sharable portion and your provider will bill you for the balance.
